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
ORDER
ON DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE GEORGIA'S ALIMONY
STATUTES UNCONSTITUTIONAL AND
ON PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO MODIFY ALIMONY

The Defendant's Motion to Declare Georgia's Alimony Statutes Unconstitutional, and Plaintiff's Motion to Modify Alimony, having come before the Court for hearing on the 8th day of March, 2005, and the Court having considered the evidence and arguments offered by Plaintiff and Defendant;

IT IS, THEREFORE, Considered, Ordered, and Adjudged as follows:

Defendant's Motion to Declare Georgia's Alimony Statutes Unconstitutional is **OVERRULED** and **DENIED**. The Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Alimony is **GRANTED**. The Defendant shall pay to the Plaintiff as temporary alimony the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) per month, beginning April 1, 2005, and continuing on the 1st day of each month until the case is resolved on a permanent basis or further Order of the Court. The payments shall be made through the Office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Colquitt County, Georgia. The statutory handling fee shall be deducted from said payment.

ORDER
ON MOTION FOR CONTEMPT

The Plaintiff's Motion for Contempt against the Defendant having come before the Court for hearing on the 8th day of March, 2005, and the Court having considered the evidence and arguments offered by Plaintiff and Defendant;

IT IS, THEREFORE, Considered, Ordered, and Adjudged as follows:

The parties in this action entered into an agreement as to certain issues on a temporary basis. That agreement was made an Order of the Court on November 19, 2003, nunc pro tunc November 11, 2003. Paragraph 3 of said order addressed personal property that Plaintiff was to have temporary use and possession of. The provisions for the actual exchange of the property were to be agreed upon or be set by the Court. These provisions were never agreed upon and the Court, by an order dated May 26, 2004, paragraph 3, set forth the provisions to accomplish the exchange of said property.

Defendant has not complied with the Court's order and acknowledges that he still retains possession of said property. Defendant testified that he has not provided said property because he was attempting to pay Plaintiff a sum of money for her interest in the property and/or that he did not know where Plaintiff was, and therefore did not know where to deliver said property. Plaintiff testified that she has been living with her mother since the separation, that her mother has lived at the same location for some time since before this action was filed, and that Defendant knew all of this.


Based upon the evidence, the Court finds that Defendant had the ability to comply with the

Court Orders but chose not to do so. His failure to do so is willful and intentional, and he is therefore in willful contempt of court.

The Defendant shall completely comply with the above referenced parts of said order on or before April 15, 2005.

Defendant shall pay Plaintiff's attorney fees incurred in this matter in the amount of \$750.00 on or before April 15, 2005. The attorney fees shall be paid to the Clerk of Superior Court of Colquitt County, Georgia. In the event said payment is not made, the Clerk shall make an affidavit of such failure to the Sheriff of Colquitt County and the Sheriff shall immediately incarcerate the Defendant in the common jail of Colquitt County, Georgia, until said amount is paid in full or further order of the Court.

SCHEDULING STATUS CONFERENCE


